What is EHE?

Epithelioid Hemangioendothelioma (EHE) is an ultra-rare vascular sarcoma, a type of cancer that grows from the cells that make up the blood vessels and can occur anywhere in the body, most commonly in the liver, lungs, and bones. The estimated incidence of EHE is less than 1 per million people.

EHE has an unpredictable clinical course, which may be indolent for years punctuated by periods of tumor growth. There are no well-established standards of care or approved treatments. Clinical outcomes are highly unpredictable and overall survival varies widely depending upon tumor location and progression. Because EHE is so rare, many doctors have no knowledge of it and patients very often experience misdiagnoses and misinformation.
